



BORDERS, BEER AND MANOR HOUSES – 1 DAY TOUR

Journey south to the Scottish Borders and discover tranquil scenery, impressive manor houses, and some of Scotland's finest craft beer. What's not to love?

Itinerary Outline:

Your Rabbie's driver-guide picks you up from your accommodation in the morning.

Your first stop is at the impressive Leaderfoot Viaduct which crosses the river Tweed near Melrose. After stretching your legs, you continue onto Abbotsford House and Gardens, home of Sir Walter Scott.

This is where the Scottish novelist, poet, playwright and historian famously collected everything from books to weapons to taxidermy.

You could spend the entire day at the estate, but you have more of the Scottish Borders to discover.

It's a short drive to Traquair House, Scotland's oldest inhabited house which dates to 1107 and has been lived in by the Stuart family since 1491. Here, you have lunch in their café followed by a tour of their 18th century brewery.

After lunch, you start your journey back towards your last stop of the day at the Cross Borders Brewery in Dalkeith, launched in 2016. Here you have a chance to try their six-beer flight in their taproom.

After the inevitable toilet break; you head back to Edinburgh in the early evening, where you can continue the party.

We highly recommend Scot Beer Tours, who offer walking tours of some of Edinburgh's craft breweries.
